A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

'Right to Establish and Control Educational Systems and Institutions'

BE IT ENACTED BY THE DALIL AZIZ HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

- SECTION 1.** Right to Establish and Control Educational systems and Institutions providing education to a manner appropriate to AMPAG cultural methods of teaching and learning.
- SECTION 2.** Guided by the purposes and principles of the Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous Peoples and good faith in the fulfillment of the obligations assumed by States in accordance with the Declaration.
- SECTION 3.** Affirming that Allodium Moorish Praedium Ante Georgia and its Nationals, being fully comprised of Indigenous Peoples (AMPAG Nationals)

have the right to preserve, use, develop, revitalize, and transmit to future generations their own histories, languages, oral traditions, philosophies, systems of knowledge, writing, and literature, and to designate and retain their own names for their communities, individuals, and places. States shall adopt adequate and effective measures to protect the exercise of this right with the full and effective participation of AMPAG nationals.

- a. AMPAG nationals has / have the right to all levels and all forms of education without discrimination.
- b. Foreign States and AMPAG Nationals, in keeping with the Principles of Equality of Opportunity, shall promote the reduction of disparities in education between AMPAG Nationals (Indigenous) and foreign (non indigenous) peoples.
- c. AMPAG Nationals has / have the right to establish and control their educational systems and institutions, providing education in their own languages, in a manner appropriate to their cultural methods of teaching and learning.
- d. States, in conjunction with AMPAG Nationals, shall take effective measures to enable AMPAG Nationals living outside their communities, particularly children, to have access to education in their own language and cultures.
- e. States shall promote harmonious intercultural relations, ensuring that the curricula of State educational systems reflect the pluricultural and multilingual nature of their societies and encourage respect for, and knowledge of, the different AMPAG National's cultures. States in conjunction with AMPAG Nationals, shall promote intercultural education that reflects the cosmosvision "(defined here as the conception that AMPAG Nationals have, both collectively and individually, of the physical and spiritual world and the environment

in which they conduct their lives),” histories, languages, knowledge, values, cultures, practices, and ways of life of those peoples.

- f. States, in conjunction with AMPAG Nationals, shall adopt necessary and effective measure to ensure the exercise and observance of those rights.

SECTION 4. This Legislation will take effect immediately after acceptance by the Dalil Aziz (Matriarchal Council) and the Wazir Al'Rais (Prime Minister) of AMPAG. All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void notwithstanding.
